We are delighted to announce our Summer Music Courses for 2024.

Please find below information on all courses and who they are suited to. *Please note, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.*

Summer Holiday KS1 Music Courses: Saturday 20th July

Our KS1 course is designed to introduce KS1 children to music through some exciting and engaging musical activities. The activities will include musical games, fun songs and the chance to perform together using a range of percussion instruments. We hope that your children will learn lots of new musical skills, which build and develop the foundations for learning instruments.

Entry requirements: No previous experience is necessary. For children in school years 1 and 2.

Session 1 for children in Year 1 only: 09.45am – 11.45am. (Please note applicants must be in Year 1 at the time of application).

Session 2 for children in Year 2 only: 12.45pm – 2.45pm. (Please note applicants must be in Year 2 at the time of application).

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Numbers will be limited so please apply early to avoid disappointment.

FREE ONLINE Summer Music Technology Courses: Saturday 20th July

Deadline for Summer Music Technology Applications - Friday 12th July 2024

Beginners Course - 9:30am – 11:00am: This session will offer you the chance to work with an online Digital Audio Workstation (DAW). You will learn how to create music electronically using loops and how to find and import loops to match sounds and styles.

Entry requirements: No previous experience necessary. For pupils in school years 5 to 13 inclusive (age 9-18). You will need a laptop or desktop computer for this course.

Using different MIDI instruments and the ability to cut/copy/paste sections you will create a new version of an existing piece of music changing not only the instrumentation but the style as well.

You will also use effects, automation and other DAW techniques to change the music.

Entry requirements: For pupils in school years 5 to 13 inclusive (age 9-18) who have had some experience using BandLab. You will need a laptop or desktop computer for this course.

Cost: FREE!

Summer Holiday Beginner Music Course: Sunday 21st July 09:45 - 15:00

This one-day course gives opportunities to take part in a range of fun musical activities, such as bucket drumming, playing boom whackers, singing, body percussion and being part of a band.

Entry requirements: For those with no musical experience through to those who are learning an instrument and are at beginner to grade 1 standard. For pupils in school years 3 to 9 (age 7-14).

Bring your own instrument if you are learning one. All instruments welcome.

Cost: £5

Summer Holiday Instrumental Course: Monday 22nd, Tuesday 23rd and Wednesday 24th July 09:45 – 15:00

Our 3-day Summer Instrumental Course will include opportunities for playing in small instrumental groups and a large ensemble. Fun musicianship activities will also be included. All instruments welcome.

Participants must attend all three days.

Concert for Friends and Family: Wednesday 24th July 2.30pm (estimated finish time approx. 3.15pm). This is a free, non-ticketed concert. **Please note there will be an opportunity to donate on the day should you wish.*

Entry requirements: For those that are grade 2 through to grade 8 standard. **This is a suggested standard for the course, you do not need to have taken the exam**. For pupils in school years 4 to 13 (age 8-18).

Bring your own instrument. All instruments welcome.
